RIFLE PERMITS

To import your rifles into South Africa you need to apply to a couple rules and regulations. The Professional Hunters Association of South Africa (<u>WWW.Professionalhunters.co.za</u>) offers a service to clients on this regard. You can contact them at reception@phasa.co.za to get this process going. Just mention that you will be hunting with Herbst Safaris to allow them to get all the correct paperwork together. CITES PERMIT

If you are going to hunt CITES animals make sure that you are bringing an original CITES import permit with from your fish and wildlife. This is valid for 12 months and could be extended.
